It was good to see your work acknowledged on the recent 'Microlive' programme on television, and it is concerning the Wafer Scale Integration project that we now write, as shareholders of Computer Associative Modules, Ltd.

On 6th November, 1985, our Solicitor, Mr. Fulton, wrote on behalf of CAM, Ltd., to your Financial Manager, Mr. Matthews, asking for an informal meeting to discuss the position of the CAM shareholders.
