Olivier de Serres (1539 – 1619) was a French agronomist and author of the book 'The Theatre of Agriculture', in which he offered biodynamic agronomic methods to cultivate fields and animals. He explained land management techniques of great importance during the time of constant war, famine and drought in France. For Serres the tilling of soil was a task inseparable from reflecting on man's use of it to the glory of God.
