OGD for repeat dilatation of benign oesophageal stricture. Complex previous history with dilatations and stents, last dilated 7/7/16 to 11mm.

Stricture at 25cm would not allow scope to pass. Dilated to 10mm, 11mm, 13.5mm with no immediate complications, after which the scope passed to D2 without difficulty. No further planned dilatations for now, but patient to contact Dr Fullard if symptoms recur, in order to organise a repeat.
